Harvest Yard Signs

Estimated project cost \$16
(not including tools or paint)

MATERIALS

- 1 – 2' x 2' x 3/4" Plywood
- 1 – 1" x 2" x 1 1/2" Pine Wood Grade Stakes
- 2 – #8 1 1/2" Wood Screws
- 1 – 100L Mini Multi Light

TOOLS USED

- Jig Saw
- Drill
- 2 1/4" Drill Bit
- Measuring Tape
- Carpenter's Square
- Clamps
- Large Paper
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Safety Goggles
- Sanding Block



MEASURE AND MARK

Using the measuring tape, measure and mark cuts on the 2' x 2' plywood according to the cut list.

To get a symmetrical fall shape fold a large sheet of paper in half and draw half of the shape along the fold (draw so your shape is 8" wide and 21" tall along fold). Cut out shape and unfold to create template (shape should now be 16" x 21"). Trace template onto plywood.



CUT

Use a jigsaw for the curved cuts on the plywood.
TIP: Use sanding block to smooth any rough edges.



PAINT OR STAIN (OPTIONAL)

Paint or stain all cut pieces prior to assembly. Option to paint the sign to look like a candy corn or ghost.



DRILL HOLES FOR LIGHTS

Using 2 1/4" drill bit carefully drill multiple holes in desired pattern. Place lights through plywood from back side.



ATTACH STAKE TO FALL SHAPE

Center stake on bottom of candy corn shape so that half of the stake is hanging off the edge (point side off the edge).

Secure stake into candy corn shape using 1 1/2" wood screws.

HARVEST YARD SIGNS

2' x 2' x 3/4" Plywood (1)
